

## Homa Bay, Kenya

The week of February 26th- 28th I traveled to Homa Bay, Kenya to teach an organization about the practices of Farming God's Way. There is a non profit organization, Spring of Hope International, working on development projects within this county that wanted to start a program focusing more on agriculture. The purpose of teaching more on agriculture is to show locals how to better care for their soil to be more productive with the crops they grow.
